



James hopes to raise \$25,000.00 or more to fund stem cell therapies or possible Kidney transplant at Northwestern Memorial Hospital in Chicago , ILL with his sister Marilyn McLester as a living donor.— Neither therapy are FULLY covered by insurance — yet could likely enhance his natural kidney function and improve the kidney disease he has battled since 2001.

James has spent over \$45,000 out of pocket working to overcome the effects of mercury on his health. “I am so thankful for all God has done,” James said. “Since 2009, I have worked with a Toxicologist, Dr. Moore, MD, as well as Dr. Chalmers, DC, Dr. Clark, MD, Dr. Von Bergen DC, and Dr. Luis Romero, MD, trying to build strength and detox. In August 2009 I tested positive for mercury using the MELISA test. Working with the doctors above, over the course of several months, one of the mercury levels dropped by 75%.” James has investigated two transplant programs and is wait-listed — with his sister, Marilyn, as a living donor. The fundraising concert will raise emergency funds so that if he does go to Chicago for the transplant, travel and lodging will be covered for Marilyn, James, and his Mother.

Recently, Dr. Romero, MD, visited James in Texas. “A door has opened for me to receive my own stem cells as a treatment to hopefully regenerate my natural kidney function after 8 years,” James said. Why stem cells, now?

1. Stem cell therapy is less expensive than a transplant. Also, James does not have a 20% Medicare supplement to pay the costs of transplant and / or costly anti-rejection medications.
2. Stem cell therapies cannot be used after a transplant, as the transplant doctors have stated twice that "Immuno-suppression" is required for transplant to prevent rejection. You first must establish kidney function and then suppress immunity, but this makes you more susceptible to diseases and infections.
3. James could receive treatment June 17-25. He could receive dialysis and stem cell therapies on two Fridays. He has someone to help him with the flight and a discounted hotel rate.
